During this test, radio frequency ablation is applied to areas of the esophagus that have been previously identified with Barrett’s esophagus. Radiofrequency ablation for both dysplastic and non-dysplastic Barrett’s esophagus was FDA approved in 2001 and has been commercially available in America for over a decade.
