About Feraheme®

Feraheme® is an IV iron infusion that is administered by a healthcare professional in an infusion center. Patients typically receive two infusions of Feraheme® separated by 3-8 days.

Indications for Use

Feraheme® is indicated for the treatment of iron deficiency anemia in adults who have intolerance to oral iron or have had unsatisfactory response to oral iron. Many patients with inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) and iron deficiency have intolerance to oral iron preparations, which may worsen IBD disease activity. It has therefore been suggested that intravenous, rather than oral, iron should be considered in patients with IBD who have anemia.
